



Funding opportunity

Snail of Approval recipients who have land set aside for food production are eligible to apply for up to \$5,000 of matched funding.

The funding program looks to support landholders in the following areas:

- ♦ Native vegetation enhancement,
- ♦ Nutrient management,
- ♦ Erosion control and remediation,
- ♦ Soil health,
- ♦ Water cycle management, and
- ♦ Pasture and grazing management.

Participation is voluntary and projects must be completed by November 2022. Funding will support up to 50% of project costs. Landholder support can be financially and/or in-kind labour.
