



Funding opportunity

Snail of Approval recipients who have land set aside for food production are eligible to apply for up to \$7,500 of matched funding to undertake on-ground projects to support sustainable farm production and native asset enhancement.

The funding program looks to support landholders in the following areas:

- Native vegetation enhancement,
- Nutrient management,
- Erosion control and remediation,
- Soil health,
- Water cycle management, and
- Pasture and grazing management.

Participation is voluntary and projects must be completed by November 2023. Funding will support up to 50% of project costs. Landholder support can be financially and/or in-kind labour.
